Essay

Add any information about yourself that you feel is important for the scholarship selection committee to know about you (such as one of eight children or single parent household). If there has been a major obstacle in your life that you have had to overcome (or are continuing to overcome), you might consider disclosing this information. Consider this essay as a way to let the committee know what type of person you are and why you deserve this award. The essay must be signed by the applicant indicating it is the applicant's original work.

Interview

As an applicant for the Matt Phillips Memorial Scholarship, you should expect to receive an email from a member of the Board of Directors of the Walt Whitman Foundation requesting a short fifteen-minute telephone interview. This interview is intended to help the Board of Directors get to know you on a more personal level than can be achieved from the scholarship application.
